# **MFA Guide**

The Microsoft Authenticator is required to have set up if you wish to access work recourses outside of the office, such as working from home.

Firstly, download the Microsoft Authenticator app on your respective app store:

Android:

### Scan the QR code

Use the Microsoft Authenticator app to scan the QR code. This will connect the Microsoft Authenticator app with your account.

After you scan the QR code, choose "Next".
